## OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:-AMRUT-Clarification on funding of AMRUT projects with respect to power component as per AMRUT-guidelines.

I am directed to refer to the reference No.SMD/ADMIN/88 dated 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2017 from the State Mission Directorate, Goa seeking clarification on the term "Power" appearing in Para 3.1.9 of the Mission guidelines as an ineligible item under AMRUT and whether items like electrical poles, fixture, cables and other allied item related to illumination in parks and NMT facilities are admissible under AMRUT.

- 2. In this regard, it is informed that the term "Power" appearing in Para 3.1.9 of the Mission guidelines as an ineligible item under AMRUT essentially means the infrastructure like power lines, transformer and ancillary equipment related to supply of power and its distribution even if it is meant to supply power to the Sewerage Treatment Plants and Water Treatment Plants. Thus, such equipment even when meant for supply of power to projects like Sewerage Treatment Plants and Water Treatment Plants cannot be taken up under AMRUT.
- 3. However, items like electric poles, fixtures and cables and related allied items for illumination in parks and NMT facilities can be taken up under the Mission if the power lines, transformers and other such equipments meant for supply of power have been made available up to the project site from funds outside AMRUT.
